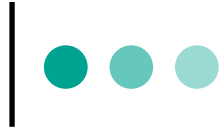

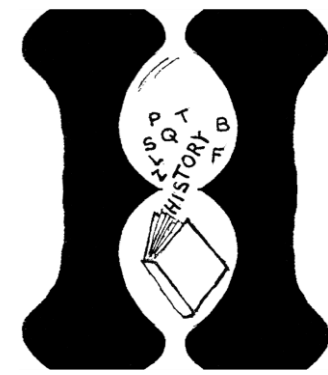

Ellen B. Wells of NLM organized and held a luncheon on June 9, 1966 at the 65th Annual Meeting of MLA in Boston. They called themselves the "History of Medicine Libraries Group."

In 1981, as MLA restructured, the group evolved to become the "History of the Health Sciences Section."
